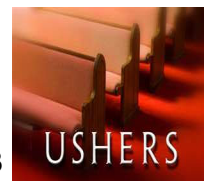

Good Friday is a day of fasting. Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are permitted one full meal and two lesser meals per day, with no eating between meals.

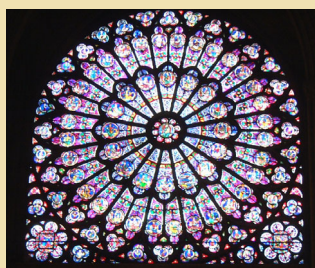
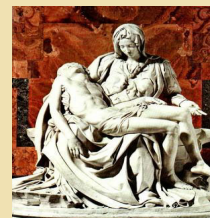
All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Catholics who are 14 years or older should abstain from meat entirely. Soups and gravies made from meat are permitted.

Visual arts and the Catholic faith have had a long and productive relationship. Art has illuminated God's revelation, taught Bible stories and illustrated the lives of the saints. But, how does art assist our prayer life? The Faith and Art Parish Mission will familiarize us with classic and contemporary works of art, assist our understanding of a work's symbolism and engage us in prayer.
